## MEMORANDUM

### SENIOR DIVISIONS

The two-year trial of two senior divisions for the State Firefighter Championships has now concluded. The TFBCA Executive Committee have endorsed this concept to continue for 2018.

Should they compete, the following teams will remain in Division A for the 2018 Championships based on their points tally from 2017:

- Claremont Blue (223)
- Devonport Green (190)
- New Norfolk (187)
- Risdon Vale Blue (163)

Should they compete, the following teams will be elevated to Division A for the 2018 Championships based on their points tally from Division B in 2017:

- Claremont Red (235)
- Ravenswood Red (148)
- Risdon Vale Red (148)

*Due to a tie on 148 points, both Ravenswood Red and Risdon Vale Red are both eligible.*

Should they compete, the following teams will be relegated to Division B for the 2018 Championships based on their points tally from Division A in 2017:

- Wynyard (145)
- Rokeby (142)

The following conditions shall be observed:

- The term "State Champion" is for the Division A winning team only.
- The winning team in Division B shall earn the title of Division B Aggregate Winner.
- The top two placed senior teams and the bottom two placed senior teams from the relevant Divisions are 'elevated' and 'relegated' each year based on their overall points total.
- There will also be a trophy for the highest overall seniors points total regardless of which Division the team is competing in.
