NEW FORM 6.9 APPLICATION TO UPGRADE TO ASE 3118

Several Fire Protection Systems Contractors are starting to install the new ASE 3118 that was discussed in [Built Environment Bulletin 01 - January 2020](#)

To assist in making this transition smoother, Tasmania Fire Service (TFS) has developed an additional Form 6.9 to allow for the correct processing of an application to replace the ASE 2118. The Form 6.9 should only be used for existing system upgrades where the alarm system has an existing ASE 2118. Where a new alarm connection is being made, permit holders are required to continue to use the Form 6.2 - Alarm Signaling Equipment (ASE) Application.

In the Built Environment Bulletin 01 – January 2020, we mentioned that there were going to be a number of information sessions run around the state for the rollout of the new ASE 3318s. Due to the Government restrictions regarding the COVID-19 virus pandemic we are no longer looking to offer those information sessions.

In their place, we are working to provide additional content for the TFS website. The next task is to create a video to demonstrate the ASE 3118 behavior. Once this is complete, we will post it on our website for reference.

We have added in an '*ASE Quick Start Guide*' and updated the '*Frequently Asked Questions*' (FAQ) to our website for your reference.
